### Relating to the Australian Capital Territory Legislative Assembly.

### LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY ORDINANCE (No. 2) 1974

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Legislative Assembly Ordinance (No. 2) 1974*.<sup>\*</sup> Short title and citation.

(2) The *Advisory Council Ordinance 1936-1974*,<sup>†</sup> as amended by the *Legislative Assembly Ordinance 1974*,<sup>‡</sup> is in this Ordinance referred to as the Principal Ordinance.

(3) Section 1 of the *Legislative Assembly Ordinance 1974* is amended by omitting sub-section (3).

(4) The Principal Ordinance, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Legislative Assembly Ordinance 1936-1974*.

2. Section 6 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting sub-section (7). Filling of vacancies.

3. (1) Section 2 of the *Legislative Assembly Ordinance 1974* is amended by omitting sub-section (2) and substituting the following sub-sections:— Amendment of the Legislative Assembly Ordinance 1974.

“ (2) Section 15 of this Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the date on which the *Legislative Assembly Ordinance (No. 2) 1974* came into operation.

“ (3) The remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall come into operation on the date fixed by the Minister by notice published in the *Gazette*.”.

(2) Section 14 of the *Legislative Assembly Ordinance 1974* is amended by omitting the word and figures “sub-section 2 (2)” and substituting the word and figures “sub-section 2 (3)”.

(3) Section 15 of the *Legislative Assembly Ordinance 1974* is amended by inserting in sub-section (3), after the words “as if”, the words “all of the provisions of”.

(4) The *Legislative Assembly Ordinance 1974*, as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Legislative Assembly (Amendment) Ordinances 1974*.
