AN ORDINANCE

Relating to the Removal of Seaweed in the Jervis Bay Territory.

SEAWEED PROTECTION ORDINANCE 1974

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Seaweed Protection Ordinance 1974*.* Short title.

2. (1) A person shall not remove seaweed from waters within the Jervis Bay Territory. Prohibition of removal or possession of seaweed at Jervis Bay.
Penalty: Two thousand dollars.

(2) A person shall not have seaweed in his possession within the Jervis Bay Territory.

Penalty: Two thousand dollars.

(3) It is a defence to a prosecution for an offence against subsection (2) that the defendant obtained the seaweed from waters outside the Jervis Bay Territory.
