To amend the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1972*.

SEAT OF GOVERNMENT (ADMINISTRATION) ORDINANCE 1976

1. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1976*.^{*} Short title and citation.

(2) The *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1972*,[†] as amended by this Ordinance, may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1976*.

2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on the date on which the *Police (Administration) Ordinance (No. 2) 1975* came into operation. Commencement.

3. The Second Schedule to the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930-1972* is amended— Second Schedule, Part I.

(a) by omitting from Part 1 the words and figures—

“*Police Ordinance 1927-1972*
Police (Disciplinary Provisions) Ordinance 1972”;
and

(b) by omitting from Part 1 the words and figures—

“*Police (Pensions) Ordinance 1958-1972*”.
