## AN ORDINANCE

To amend the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933*.

### NURSES REGISTRATION (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1977

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Nurses Registration (Amendment) Ordinance 1977*.<sup>\*</sup> Short title.

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Nurses Registration Ordinance 1933*.<sup>†</sup> Principal Ordinance.

3. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in sub-section (1), after the definition of "the Court of Petty Sessions", the following definition:— Interpretation.

" 'the Deputy Chairman' means the Deputy Chairman of the Board;".

4. After section 6 of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:—

" 6A. (1) The members shall elect one of their number to be Deputy Chairman of the Board. Deputy Chairman.

" (2) A member elected as Deputy Chairman holds office as Deputy Chairman for a period of 1 year from the date of his election or until he sooner ceases to be a member.

" (3) A member is eligible to be re-elected as Deputy Chairman.

“(4) The Deputy Chairman may resign his office of Deputy Chairman by writing under his hand delivered to the Chairman.”.

**5.** Section 24A of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by inserting in sub-section (1), after the words “the Chairman”, the words “or, if for any reason the Chairman is unable to act, the Deputy Chairman”; and
- (b) by inserting in sub-section (2), after the words “the Chairman”, the words “or, if for any reason the Chairman is unable to act, the Deputy Chairman”.

**6.** Section 28P of the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in sub-section (1), after the words “the Chairman”, the words “or, if for any reason the Chairman is unable to act, the Deputy Chairman”.
