COMPANIES (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1977

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Companies (Amendment) Ordinance 1977*.^{*} Short title.

2. Section 8 of the *Companies Ordinance 1962*[†] is amended by omitting sub-section (11) and substituting the following sub-section:— Companies Auditors Board.

“(11) The Board is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.”.
