POLICE (DISCIPLINARY PROVISIONS) (AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE 1978

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Police (Disciplinary Provisions) (Amendment) Ordinance 1978*.^{*} Short title

2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on 16 November 1976. Commencement

3. After section 6 of the *Police (Disciplinary Provisions) Ordinance 1972*† the following section is inserted:

“6A. The Board is a prescribed authority for the purposes of the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*.”. Fees and allowances
