An Ordinance relating to the remuneration of members of the House of Assembly

HOUSE OF ASSEMBLY (REMUNERATION) ORDINANCE 1979

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *House of Assembly Short title (Remuneration) Ordinance 1979*.¹

2. This Ordinance is incorporated and shall be read as one with the *House of Assembly Ordinance 1936*.

Incorporation with
House of Assembly Ordinance 1936

3. In this Ordinance, "the Determination" means the determination made by the Remuneration Tribunal on 19 June 1978 in pursuance of sub-sections 7 (3) and 7 (4) of the *Remuneration Tribunals Act 1973* in relation to the remuneration to be paid to the holders of offices in the First Division of the Australian Public Service and to the holders of public offices.

Interpretation

Assembly members to be remunerated under this Ordinance until determination made under *Remuneration Tribunals Act 1973*

4. Until a member of the Assembly becomes entitled to receive remuneration and allowances by virtue of a determination under the *Remuneration Tribunals Act 1973*, he shall receive, in respect of his service as such a member, remuneration and allowances in accordance with this Ordinance.

Remuneration of President

5. The President shall receive—

- (a) remuneration at the rate of \$9,000 per annum; and
- (b) an allowance at the rate of \$1,250 per annum.

Remuneration of member other than President

6. A member of the Assembly, other than the President, shall receive—

- (a) remuneration at the rate of \$6,000 per annum; and
- (b) an allowance at the rate of \$750 per annum.

Travelling allowance

7. A member of the Assembly shall receive travelling allowance in the same circumstances, and in the same amount, as if—

- (a) he were the holder, on a part-time basis, of a public office within the meaning of the *Remuneration Tribunals Act 1973*; and
- (b) that public office were an office to which the Determination applied.
