An Ordinance to amend the *Money Lenders Ordinance 1936*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Money Lenders (Amendment) Ordinance 1982*.¹

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Money Lenders Ordinance 1936*.²

Interpretation

3. Section 4 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting "Attorney-General" from the definition of "money lender" in sub-section (1) and substituting "Minister".

Regulations

4. Section 16 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting "Attorney-General" and substituting "Minister".

Transitional

5. Where, immediately before the commencement of this Ordinance, a body corporate was, by order of the Attorney-General, exempted from registration under the Principal Ordinance, that order shall continue to have effect as if—

- (a) this Ordinance had come into operation before the order was made;
- and

- (b) the order had been made by the Minister of State for the Capital Territory under the Principal Ordinance as amended by this Ordinance.
