

## Seat of Government (Administration) (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 4) 1982

An Ordinance to amend the *Seat of Government (Administration)  
Ordinance 1930*

### Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) (Amendment) Ordinance (No. 4) 1982*.<sup>1</sup>

### Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930*.<sup>2</sup>

3. After section 6 of the Principal Ordinance the following section is inserted:

### Delegation of Ministers' powers under Ordinances

"7. (1) A Minister may, either generally or as otherwise provided by the instrument of delegation, by writing signed by him, delegate to a person any of his powers under an Ordinance.

"(2) A power so delegated, when exercised by the delegate, shall, for the purposes of the Ordinance conferring the power, be deemed to have been exercised by the Minister who delegated the power.

"(3) A delegation under this section does not prevent the exercise of a power by, or for and on behalf of, a Minister.

“(4) In sub-section (1), a reference to a Minister shall be read as not including a reference to the Minister of State for the Capital Territory.”.

**Second Schedule**

4. The Second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by inserting in Part I—

“*Court of Petty Sessions (Civil Jurisdiction) Ordinance 1982*”

after—

“*Court of Petty Sessions Ordinance 1930*”.
