(Amendment) Ordinance 1983**

An Ordinance to amend the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Seat of Government (Administration) (Amendment) Ordinance 1983*.¹

Principal Ordinance

2. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930*.²

Administration of Ordinances

3. Section 10 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

- (a) by omitting from sub-section (1) "Minister of State for the Capital Territory" and substituting "Minister of State for Territories and Local Government"; and
- (b) by omitting from sub-section (4A) "Minister of State for Education" and substituting "Minister of State for Education and Youth Affairs".

Second Schedule

4. The Second Schedule to the Principal Ordinance is amended by omitting from the heading to Part 4 "MINISTER OF STATE FOR EDUCATION" and substituting "MINISTER OF STATE FOR EDUCATION AND YOUTH AFFAIRS".
