An Ordinance to amend the *Remuneration Ordinance 1976*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Remuneration (Amendment) Ordinance 1984*.¹

Commencement

2. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into operation on 6 October 1983.
