An Ordinance to amend the *Poker Machine Control Ordinance 1975*

Short title

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the *Poker Machine Control (Amendment) Ordinance 1984*.¹

Commencement

2. This Ordinance shall come into operation on such date as is fixed by the Minister of State for Territories and Local Government by notice in the *Gazette*.

Principal Ordinance

3. In this Ordinance, "Principal Ordinance" means the *Poker Machine Control Ordinance 1975*.²

Interpretation

4. Section 3 of the Principal Ordinance is amended by adding “and any prescribed machine” at the end of the definition of “poker machine”.

Distribution of income from poker machines

5. Section 41 of the Principal Ordinance is amended—

(a) by omitting from sub-section (1) “an amount equal to 10 per cent of the gross revenue derived by the club from operating poker machines on the club premises during that month” and substituting “the prescribed amount in relation to that month”; and

(b) by inserting after sub-section (1) the following sub-section:

“(1A) For the purposes of this section, the prescribed amount in relation to a month is an amount equal to 10% of the gross revenue derived by the club from operating poker machines on the club premises during that month, or, if another percentage for the purposes of this section is determined by the Minister by notice in the *Gazette*, that other percentage of that gross revenue.”.
