REGULATIONS RELATING TO INFECTIOUS DISEASES UNDER THE
PUBLIC HEALTH ORDINANCE 1912. (No. 4 of 1912.)

Amendment of Infectious Diseases Regulations 1914.

The Infectious Diseases Regulations 1914 are amended by inserting in Regulations 4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17 thereof, after the words "Medical Officer of Health" (wherever occurring) the words "or other person authorized by the Minister".
