

THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

Regulations under the Public Health Ordinance 1928-1930.

I JOHN McNEILL, Minister of State for Health, acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for Home Affairs, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930*, and the *Public Health Ordinance 1928-1930*, hereby make the following Regulations to come into operation forthwith.

PUBLIC HEALTH (MEAT) REGULATIONS.

1. The Public Health (Meat) Regulations are amended by the addition of the following sub-clause to clause four:—

“ Any licence issued under these regulations before 31st December, 1931, may be issued as having effect until 31st December, 1932, upon payment of a single fee of One pound in respect of such licence.” Extending period of validity of licences.
