

# THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

## Regulations under the Advisory Council Ordinance 1930-1931.

### AMENDMENT OF THE ADVISORY COUNCIL ELECTION REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 9 of the Advisory Council Election Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (3.) the words "Liquor Poll held in pursuance of the *Liquor Poll Ordinances 1928* or on the roll prepared in pursuance of the Seat of Government Electoral Regulations (Statutory Rules 1928, No. 116)" and inserting in their stead the words "election held on the seventeenth day of May One thousand nine hundred and thirty in pursuance of the Ordinance".

2. Regulation 50 of the Advisory Council Election Regulations is amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (1.) the words "Liquor Poll held in pursuance of the *Liquor Poll Ordinances* 1928 or on the roll prepared in pursuance of the Seat of Government Election Regulations (Statutory Rules 1928, No. 116)" and inserting in their stead the words "election held on the seventeenth day of May One thousand nine hundred and thirty in pursuance of the Ordinance".

3. Form 9 in the Schedule to the Advisory Council Election Regulations is amended by omitting the words "Liquor Poll held in pursuance of the *Liquor Poll Ordinances* 1928 or on the roll prepared in pursuance of the Seat of Government Electoral Regulations (Statutory Rules 1928, No. 116)" and inserting in their stead the words "election held on the seventeenth day of May One thousand nine hundred and thirty in pursuance of the Ordinance".
