Regulations under the Companies Ordinance 1931.

AMENDMENT OF THE COMPANIES REGULATIONS.

The Schedule to the Companies Regulations is amended-

- (a) by omitting the figures "100" from Item 2 and inserting in their stead the figures "20";
- (b) by omitting the figures "40" from Item 4 and inserting in their stead the figures "20";
- (c) by omitting the figures "25" from Item 9 and inserting in their stead the figures "20"; and
- (d) by adding at the end of that Item the following proviso:
 - "Provided also that in no case shall the maximum fees 'for registration whether in respect of capital as originally stated, or as increased, exceed £20.".
