Regulations under the Public Health Ordinance 1928-1930.

AMENDMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH (DAIRY) REGULATIONS.

1. The Second Schedule, being the milk standard prescribed under regulation forty of the Public Health (Dairy) Regulations is repealed and the following schedule inserted in its stead:-

Public Health (Dairy) Regulations.

MILK STANDARD.

Milk shall contain not less than eight and live-tenths parts per centum of milk solids not fat, and three and five-tenths parts per centum of milk fat.

It shall contain not more than 100.000 micro-organisms per cubic centimetre

estimated by the direct count method.

- 2. Regulation thirty-three A is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead :-
- "33A.—(1.) The Minister may appoint any qualified person to be an analyst for the purpose of the examination or analysis of milk or cream under these Regulations;
- (2.) A certificate purporting to be signed by any analyst so appointed shall be prima facie evidence of the facts stated therein."
