

# THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

## Regulations under the Public Health Ordinance 1928-1930.

I WILLIAM MORRIS HUGHES, the Minister of State for Health, acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Seat of Government (Administration) Ordinance 1930* and the *Public Health Ordinance 1928-1930*, hereby make the following Regulation.

### AMENDMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH (BOARDING HOUSES) REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 5 of the Public Health (Boarding Houses) Regulations is amended—

(a) by omitting from sub-regulation (1) the words “and forward therewith an application fee of Ten shillings”; and

(b) by omitting from sub-regulation (5) the words “and pay a renewal fee therefor of Ten shillings”.

2. The Schedule to the Public Health (Boarding Houses) Regulations is amended by omitting from Form A the words “The registration fee of 10s. is forwarded herewith in the form of cash, cheque, postal note.”.
