

THE TERRITORY FOR THE SEAT OF GOVERNMENT.

Regulations under the Public Baths Ordinance 1931-1936.

AMENDMENT OF PUBLIC BATHS REGULATIONS.

Regulation 11 of the Public Baths Regulations is repealed, and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

“11. The hours of admission to any public baths during the swimming season shall be as follows:—

Week-days—6.30 a.m. to 12 noon and 12.30 p.m. to 9 p.m.

Sundays—7.30 a.m. to 1 p.m. and 2 p.m. to 6.30 p.m.”
