AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY.

Regulations under the National Capital Development Ordinance 1938.

I HERBERT BRAYLEY COLLETT, a Member of the Federal Executive Council, acting for and on behalf of the Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *National Capital Development Ordinance 1938*, hereby make the following Regulations.

NATIONAL CAPITAL PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE (EXPENSES) REGULATIONS.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the National Capital Planning and Development Committee (Expenses) Regulations. Short title.

2. Subject to the provisions of section four of the *National Capital Development Ordinance 1938*, a member of the Committee who is engaged on the business of the Committee away from his home shall be entitled to receive—

- (a) the amount actually incurred by him as the cost of conveyance in travelling for the purposes of that business; and
- (b) a travelling allowance of Three pounds three shillings per day for each day that he is engaged on that business.
