## Regulations 1940. No. 8.

### Regulation under the Fish Protection Ordinance 1929-1936.\*

I HATTIL SPENCER FOLL, the Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Fish Protection Ordinance 1929-1936*, hereby make the following Regulations.

#### AMENDMENT OF THE FISH PROTECTION REGULATIONS.

1. Regulation 3 of the Fish Protection Regulations is amended by adding at the end of the definition of "Registrar" the words "and any person who, in relation to any act or duty, is directed or appointed in writing by the Minister to perform that act or duty". Definition of "Registrar:"

2. Regulation 4A. is amended by omitting sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in lieu thereof the following sub-regulation. Fees:

(1.) The following fees shall be payable to the Registrar for a licence to take fish:—
