Regulations 1943. No. 7.*

Regulation under the Public Baths Ordinance 1931-1940.

I JOSEPH SILVER COLLINGS, the Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Baths Ordinance* 1931-1940 hereby make the following Regulation.

AMENDMENT OF THE PUBLIC BATHS REGULATIONS.

Regulation 5 of the Public Baths Regulations is amended by **Offences.** inserting after paragraph (f) the following paragraphs:—

- “(g) by forcible or improper means, compels any other person to enter the water in the swimming pool;
- (h) goes upon a spring board whilst any other person is on that springboard; or
- (i) climbs on any portion of the steel framework supporting a springboard, other than the ladder provided for the purpose of approaching the springboard.”
