## Regulations 1943. No. 8.\*

### Regulations under the Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936-1943.

I JOSEPH SILVER COLLINGS, Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the *Motor Traffic Ordinance 1936-1943* hereby make the following Regulations.

#### AMENDMENT OF THE MOTOR TRAFFIC REGULATIONS.

1. The Limitation of Speed Order made by the Minister on the twenty-eighth day of February, One thousand nine hundred and thirty-three is hereby repealed. Repeal of Order.

2. The Motor Traffic Regulations are amended by adding, after regulation 33, the following regulations:—

“34. The limit of speed at which any motor vehicle or class of motor vehicle may travel in the public streets within the City Area, as defined in the *City Area Leases Ordinance 1936-1938*, shall be thirty miles per hour. Limitation of speed—city area.”

“35. The limit of speed at which any motor vehicle or class of motor vehicle may travel in any public street or road outside the City Area, as defined by the *City Area Leases Ordinance 1936-1938*, shall be thirty miles per hour.” Limitation of speed—outside city area.

3. The Third Schedule to the Motor Traffic Regulations is amended by inserting after the word “Parkes” (second occurring) the following paragraphs:— Prohibition of standing or parking in certain places.

Public streets adjacent to and on the north-eastern and south-eastern sides of Commonwealth Offices, East Block.

Public streets adjacent to and on the north-eastern and north-western sides of Commonwealth Offices, West Block.
