Regulations under the Police Ordinance 1927-1950.

AMENDMENTS OF THE POLICE REGULATIONS.

- 1. Regulation 2 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting Definitions. from the definition of "the Secretary" the words "Attorney-General's Department" and inserting in their stead the words "Department of the Interior".
- 2. Regulation 3 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting the Appointment word "Attorney-General" and inserting in its stead the word chief officer. "Minister".
- 3. Regulation 4 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting Responsibilities the word "Attorney-General" and inserting in its stead the word of the Chief "Minister".
- 4. Regulation 11 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting offences from sub-regulations (2.) and (3.) the word "Attorney-General" punishable by Chief (wherever occurring) and inserting in its stead the word "Minister".
- 5. Regulation 11a of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting offences the word "Attorney-General" (wherever occurring) and inserting in punishable its stead the word "Minister".
- 6. Regulation 15AA of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting Deduction from from sub-regulation (2.) the word "Attorney-General" and inserting recreation leave in its stead the word "Minister".
- 7. Regulation 16 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting sick leave. from sub-regulation (2A.) the word "Attorney-General" and inserting in its stead the word "Minister".

8. Regulation 18 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-regulations (1.), (2.) and (3.) the word "Attorney-General" and inserting in its stead the word "Minister".

Extended leave or pay in lieu to members of the Force not entitled to furlough. 9. Regulation 19 of the Police Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-regulations (1.), (2.), (3.) and (4.) the word "Attorney-General" (wherever occurring) and inserting in its stead the word "Minister".
