Regulations under the Education Ordinance 1937-1952.*

Amendment of the Education Regulations.

- 1. Regulation 27 of the Education Regulations is amended-
 - (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (1.) the candidates figures "656", "736", "816", "896", "976" and eligible.
 "1056" and inserting in their stead the figures "756",
 "836", "916", "996", "1,076" and "1,156", respectively; and
 - (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (1.) the figures "806", "886", "966", "1046". "1126" and "1206" and inserting in their stead the figures "906", "986", "1,066", "1,146", "1,226" and "1,306", respectively.
- 2. These Regulations shall be deemed to have come into operation commencements on the thirtieth day of September, 1952.
