Regulation under the Public Baths Ordinance 1931-1953.*

I WILFRED SELWYN KENT HUGHES, Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Public Baths Ordinance 1931-1953*, hereby make the following Regulation.

AMENDMENT OF THE PUBLIC BATHS REGULATIONS.†

Regulation 10 of the Public Baths Regulations is repealed and the following regulations are inserted in its stead:—

“10.—(1.) Subject to this regulation, the charge for admission to public baths shall be in accordance with the following table:— Charges for admission.

“ (2.) The charge for admission to public baths for a school child in charge of a teacher shall be three pence.

“ (3.) A charge shall not be made for the admission to public baths of a child who has not attained the age of five years.

“10AA. The charge for a service referred to in the following table shall be in accordance with that table:— Hire charges.
