Regulations 1956. No. 10.

Regulations under the Education Ordinance 1937-1952.*

I ALLEN FAIRHALL, the Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the *Education Ordinance* 1937-1952, hereby make the following Regulations.

AMENDMENTS OF THE EDUCATION REGULATIONS.†

- 1.—(1.) Regulation 18 of the Education Regulations is amended by omitting from paragraph (d) of sub-regulation (1.) the words “one penny” and inserting in their stead the word “Threepence”. Circumstances in which school conveyance grant not payable.
- (2.) The last preceding sub-regulation shall come into operation on the third day of December, 1956.

2. Regulation 27 of the Education Regulations is amended—

- (a) by omitting from paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (1.) the figures “800”, “880”, “960”, “1,040”, “1,120” and “1,200” and inserting in their stead the figures “875”, “955”, “1,035”, “1,115”, “1,195” and “1,275”, respectively; and
- (b) by omitting from paragraph (b) of sub-regulation (1.) the figures “950”, “1,030”, “1,110”, “1,190”, “1,270” and “1,350” and inserting in their stead the figures “1,025”, “1,105”, “1,185”, “1,265”, “1,345” and “1,425”, respectively. Candidates eligible.
