### Regulations 1956. No. 5.

## Regulations under the Roads and Public Places Ordinance 1937.\*

I, ALLEN FAIRHALL, the Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the Roads and Public Places Ordinance 1937, hereby make the following Regulations.

#### ROADS AND PUBLIC PLACES REGULATIONS.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Roads and Public Places <sub>Citation</sub>. Regulations.

2. The prescribed fee for opening up, or breaking the surface of, a  $\mathbf{r}_{\text{ces.}}$  public road is the fee specified in the Schedule to these Regulations opposite to the type of surface of the public road.

#### THE SCHEDULE.

Regulation 2.

Type of road surface.	Fee.
Concrete pavement	£15 or an amount calculated at the rate of £1 for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater
Bitumenous macadam pavement	£5 or an amount calculated at the rate of 3s. 3d. for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater
Bitumenous surfaced pavement	£5 or an amount calculated at the rate of 1s. 9d. for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater
Gravel pavement	£3 or an amount calculated at the rate of 1s. 3d. for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater
