Regulations 1956. No. 7.

Regulations under the Fish Protection Ordinance 1929-1949.*

I ALLEN FAIRHALL, the Minister of State for the Interior, in pursuance of the powers conferred on me by the *Fish Protection Ordinance 1929-1949*, hereby make the following Regulations.

AMENDMENTS OF THE FISH PROTECTION REGULATIONS.†

1. Regulation 7 of the Fish Protection Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-regulation:—

“(1.) A person shall not take trout (*Salmo fario* or *Salmo irideus*) from any waters during the period commencing on the first day of May and ending on the thirty-first day of August in each year.”

2. Regulation 9 of the Fish Protection Regulations is amended by omitting from table (2.) in sub-regulation (1.) the words and figures—

“ Brown Trout	<i>Salmo fario</i>	12
Salmon Trout	<i>Salmo eriox</i>	12
Rainbow Trout	<i>Salmo irideus</i>	12

and inserting in their stead the words and figures—

“ Brown Trout	<i>Salmo fario</i>	10
Salmon Trout	<i>Salmo eriox</i>	10
Rainbow Trout	<i>Salmo irideus</i>	10”
