Regulations under the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1955.*

AMENDMENT OF THE CANBERRA COMMUNITY HOSPITAL (CHARGES) REGULATIONS.†

- 1. These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of Commencement. December, 1956.
- 2. Regulation 5 of the Cauberra Community Hospital (Charges) Charges for Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-regulation:—
- "(1.) Subject to regulation 9 of these Regulations, the charge for treatment provided by the Board for an in-patient is at the rate of—
 - (a) One pound four shillings per day in respect of an in-patient in a general ward;
 - (b) One pound sixteen shillings per day in respect of an inpatient in an intermediate ward; and
 - (c) Two pounds two shillings per day in respect of an in-patient in a private ward.".
