## Regulations 1956. No. 8.

### Regulations under the Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1955.\*

I DONALD ALASTAIR CAMERON, the Minister of State for Health, in pursuance of the powers conferred by the *Canberra Community Hospital Ordinance 1938-1955*, hereby make the following Regulations.

#### AMENDMENT OF THE CANBERRA COMMUNITY HOSPITAL (CHARGES) REGULATIONS.†

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of Commencement, December, 1956.

2. Regulation 5 of the Canberra Community Hospital (Charges) Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-regulation:—

“(1.) Subject to regulation 9 of these Regulations, the charge for treatment provided by the Board for an in-patient is at the rate of—

- (a) One pound four shillings per day in respect of an in-patient in a general ward;
- (b) One pound sixteen shillings per day in respect of an in-patient in an intermediate ward; and
- (c) Two pounds two shillings per day in respect of an in-patient in a private ward.”.
