Regulation under the *Public Health Ordinance 1928-1951*.*

AMENDMENTS OF THE PUBLIC HEALTH (INFECTIOUS AND NOTIFIABLE DISEASES) REGULATIONS.†

Regulation 3 of the Public Health (Infectious and Notifiable Diseases) Regulations is amended—

(a) by inserting after paragraph (a) of the definition of “notifiable disease” in sub-regulation (1.) the following paragraph:—

“ (aa) breast abscess occurring within six weeks of childbirth; ”; and

(b) by inserting after paragraph (k) of that definition the following paragraph:—

“ (ka) mastitis occurring within six weeks of childbirth; ”.
