Regulations under the *Machinery Ordinance 1949*.*

I. GORDON FREETH, the Minister of State for the Interior, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Machinery Ordinance 1949*.

AMENDMENTS OF THE BOILERS AND PRESSURE VESSELS REGULATIONS.†

1. Regulation 5 of the Boilers and Pressure Vessels Regulations is amended by omitting the definition of "maximum allowable working pressure" and inserting in its stead the following definition:—

" 'maximum allowable working pressure', in relation to a boiler or pressure vessel, means the maximum allowable working pressure specified in the certificate of inspection for the time being in force in relation to the boiler or pressure vessel;".

2. Regulation 22 of the Boilers and Pressure Vessels Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulation (2.).

Boilers and pressure vessels not to be used without certificate of inspection.

3. Regulation 24 of the Boilers and Pressure Vessels Regulations is amended by omitting paragraph (a) of sub-regulation (1.) and inserting in its stead the following paragraph:—

Certificate of inspection.

" (a) issue to the operator a certificate of inspection; and "

4. Regulation 39 of the Boilers and Pressure Vessels Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the words "in accordance with Form 2 in the First Schedule to these Regulations".

Issue of boiler attendant's certificate.

5. The First Schedule to the Boiler and Pressure Vessels Regulations is repealed.
