AMENDMENTS OF THE CANBERRA PUBLIC CEMETERY REGULATIONS.†

- 1. Regulation 2 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is amended Definitions by omitting from sub-regulation (2.) all words after the word "Regulations" (second occurring).
- 2. Regulation 10 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is Office hours. amended by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the words "Saturdays—10 a.m. to 12 noon."
- 3. Regulation 15 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is Exclusive rights amended—
 - (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the words "in accordance with Form A" and inserting in their stead the words "for the grant of that right";
 - (b) by omitting from sub-regulation (3.) the words "in accordance with Form B" and inserting in their stead the words " to that effect".
- **4.** Regulation 18 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is Permit for amended by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the words "in accordance burial. with Form C".
- 5. The First Schedule to the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is First Schedule. repealed.
