Regulations under the *Cemeteries Ordinance* 1933-1959.*

AMENDMENTS OF THE CANBERRA PUBLIC CEMETERY REGULATIONS.†

1. Regulation 2 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is amended Definitions by omitting from sub-regulation (2.) all words after the word "Regulations" (second occurring).

2. Regulation 10 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is Office hours. amended by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the words "Saturdays—10 a.m. to 12 noon."

3. Regulation 15 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is Exclusive rights amended— to burial.

(a) by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the words "in accordance with Form A" and inserting in their stead the words "for the grant of that right";

(b) by omitting from sub-regulation (3.) the words "in accordance with Form B" and inserting in their stead the words "to that effect".

4. Regulation 18 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is Permit for amended by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the words "in accordance with Form C". burial.

5. The First Schedule to the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is First Schedule. repealed.
