Regulations under the *Roads and Public Places Ordinance 1937*.*

I GORDON FREETH, the Minister of State for the Interior, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Roads and Public Places Ordinance 1937*.

ROADS AND PUBLIC PLACES REGULATIONS.

1. These Regulations may be cited as the *Roads and Public Places Short title Regulations*.

2. The *Roads and Public Places Regulations*, being Regulations 1956, Repeal No. 5, are repealed.

3. For the purposes of section 9 of the *Roads and Public Places Ordinance 1937*, the prescribed fee for the opening up, or breaking the surface of—

(a) the carriage-way of a public road is the fee specified in the First Schedule to these Regulations opposite to the type of surface of the carriage-way; and

(b) a footpath or the drive-way between the carriage-way of a public road and the boundary of a parcel of land is the fee specified in the Second Schedule to these Regulations opposite to the type of surface of the footpath or drive-way.

THE SCHEDULES.

FIRST SCHEDULE.

Regulation 3 (a).

Type of surface.	Fee.
Concrete pavement	£15 or an amount calculated at the rate of £1 for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.
Bituminous macadam pavement	£5 or an amount calculated at the rate of 3s. 3d. for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.
Bituminous surfaced pavement . .	£5 or an amount calculated at the rate of 1s. 9d. for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.
Gravel pavement	£3 or an amount calculated at the rate of 1s. 3d. for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.

SECOND SCHEDULE.

Regulation 3 (b).

Type of surface.	Fee.
Concrete pavement	£3 or an amount calculated at the rate of 3s. 3d. for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.
Bituminous macadam pavement	£2 or an amount calculated at the rate of 1s. 9d. for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.
Bituminous surfaced pavement . .	£2 or an amount calculated at the rate of 1s. 9d. for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.
Gravel pavement	£1 or an amount calculated at the rate of 1s. 3d. for each square foot or part of a square foot of the surface opened up or broken, whichever is the greater.
