PUBLIC HEALTH (PROHIBITED DRUGS) REGULATIONS

REGULATIONS 1965, No. 1*

- Citation.** 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) Regulations.
- Repeal.** 2. The Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) Regulations (comprising Regulations 1957, No. 12 and 1962, No. 9) are repealed.
- Prohibited drugs.** 3. For the purposes of the *Public Health (Prohibited Drugs) Ordinance 1957*—
- (a) the drug diamorphine is a prohibited drug;
 - (b) the salts of the drug diamorphine and a preparation, admixture or other substance containing the drug diamorphine or a salt or salts of the drug diamorphine are prohibited drugs;
 - (c) the drug thalidomide is a prohibited drug;
 - (d) a preparation, admixture or other substance containing the drug thalidomide is a prohibited drug;
 - (e) the drug ketobemidone is a prohibited drug;
 - (f) the salts of the drug ketobemidone and a preparation, admixture or other substance containing the drug ketobemidone or a salt or salts of the drug ketobemidone are prohibited drugs;
 - (g) the drug cannabis is a prohibited drug; and
 - (h) an extract of the drug cannabis and a preparation, admixture or other substance containing the drug cannabis or an extract of the drug cannabis are prohibited drugs.
