

CEMETERIES ORDINANCE

CANBERRA PUBLIC CEMETERY REGULATIONS*

REGULATIONS 1968, No. 4†

1. Regulation 35 of the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is amended Penalty. by omitting the words "Ten pounds" and inserting in their stead the words "Twenty dollars".

2. The Third Schedule to the Canberra Public Cemetery Regulations is Third Schedule. repealed and the following Schedule inserted in its stead:—

4. Burial, in a grave excavated to a depth not exceeding five feet, of—	
(a) a person of four years of age or more on—	
(i) a Sunday or holiday	46.00
(ii) a Saturday	34.00
(iii) any other day	28.00
(b) a child under four years of age (including a still-born child) on—	
(i) a Sunday or holiday	28.00
(ii) a Saturday	22.00
(iii) any other day	19.00
5. Burial, in a grave excavated to a depth of six feet—the fee that would be payable if the burial were in a grave excavated to a depth not exceeding five feet together with an additional fee of Eight dollars.	
6. Interment of ashes	4.00
7. Exhumation and reburial in same allotment in the Cemetery (not including removal and replacement of any memorial or other improvement to an allotment)	50.00
8. Exhumation and reburial in another allotment in the Cemetery (not including removal and replacement of any memorial or other improvement to an allotment)	68.00
9. Exhumation for removal of body to another cemetery (not including removal and replacement of any memorial or other improvement to an allotment) ..	50.00
10. Application under regulation 26 (1.) for permission to erect kerbing or railing only	1.50
11. Application under regulation 26 (1.) for permission to erect, on an allotment, a monument, tablet, gravestone, vault or other structure, together with any kerbing or railing to be erected at the same time	3.00
12. Application under regulation 26 (1.) for permission to erect, other than on an allotment, a monument or other structure	7.50
13. (a) Supplying and fixing a tablet in a lawn burial area and inscribing with the number of the grave and not more than forty other characters	10.00
(b) Inscribing on a tablet in a lawn burial area characters in excess of those covered by the last preceding paragraph—an amount equal to the cost to the Trustees.
