REGULATIONS‡**

REGULATIONS 1970 No. 2§

Definitions.

1. Regulation 2 of the Public Health (Medical and Dental Inspection of School Children) Regulations is amended by inserting, after the definition of "Authorized medical officer", the following definition:—

" 'Dental therapist' means a person who occupies, or is employed to perform the duties of, an office under the *Public Service Act* 1922-1968 of Dental Therapist (Female);".

2. Regulation 4 of the Public Health (Medical and Dental Inspection of School Children) Regulations is amended— **Dental examinations.**

- (a) by inserting in sub-regulation (1.), after the words “ authorized dentist”, the words “ or an authorized dental therapist”; and
- (b) by inserting in sub-regulation (2.), after the word “ dentist”, the words “ or dental therapist”.

3. Regulation 5 of the Public Health (Medical and Dental Inspection of School Children) Regulations is amended by omitting the words “ the authorized medical officer, or authorized dentist,” and inserting in their stead the words “ an authorized medical officer or an authorized dentist”. **Head teacher to carry out instructions.**
