REGULATIONS 1970 No. 2§

Definitions.

- 1. Regulation 2 of the Public Health (Medical and Dental Inspection of School Children) Regulations is amended by inserting, after the definition of "Authorized medical officer", the following definition:-
 - "'Dental therapist' means a person who occupies, or is employed to perform the duties of, an office under the Public Service Act 1922-1968 of Dental Therapist (Female);".

- 2. Regulation 4 of the Public Health (Medical and Dental Inspection of Dental School Children) Regulations is amended—
 - (a) by inserting in sub-regulation (1.), after the words "authorized dentist", the words "or an authorized dental therapist"; and
 - (b) by inserting in sub-regulation (2.), after the word "dentist", the words "or dental therapist".
- 3. Regulation 5 of the Public Health (Medical and Dental Inspection of Head teacher School Children) Regulations is amended by omitting the words "the authorized to carry out instructions, medical officer, or authorized dentist," and inserting in their stead the words "an authorized medical officer or an authorized dentist".
