AMENDMENTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH MOTOR OMNIBUS FARES REGULATIONS?

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on the first day of November, Commencement. 1971.

2. Regulation 6 of the Commonwealth Motor Omnibus Fares Regulations is Children's amended-

- (a) by omitting from sub-regulation (3.) the words "Two cents" and inserting in their stead the words "Five cents";
- (b) by omitting from sub-regulation (4.) the words "Two cents" and inserting in their stead the words "Five cents";
- (c) by adding at the end thereof the following sub-regulation:—
 - "(5.) Where, on an application made for the purpose by the father, mother or guardian of a schoolchild, the Minister is satisfied that payment of fares in accordance with either of the last two preceding sub-regulations has caused hardship to the applicant, the Minister may direct that a refund be made to the applicant of the fares, or a specified part of the fares, so paid by the schoolchild. and a refund shall be made to the applicant accordingly.".
