Regulations under the *Milk Authority Ordinance 1971-1972*.*

I RALPH JAMES DUNNET HUNT, the Minister of State for the Interior, hereby make the following Regulations under the *Milk Authority Ordinance 1971-1972*.

AMENDMENTS OF THE MILK AUTHORITY REGULATIONS†

1. After regulation 1 of the Milk Authority Regulations the following regulation is inserted:—

“ 1A. In these Regulations, unless the contrary intention appears, ‘cream’ does not include sour cream.”. Definition.

2. Regulation 5 of the Milk Authority Regulations is repealed and the following regulation inserted in its stead:—

“ 5. The annual fee payable in respect of a wholesaler’s licence is—

(a) where the holder of the licence is the holder of not more than one such licence—the sum of—

(i) Ten dollars; and

(ii) an amount calculated at the rate of 0.15 cents per gallon of milk received into the premises specified in that licence by him in the course of the business to which the licence relates during the term of the licence last preceding the date on which the fee becomes payable; and

(b) where the holder of the licence is the holder of more than one such licence—the sum of—

(i) Ten dollars; and

(ii) an amount equal to an amount calculated at the rate of 0.15 cents per gallon of milk received into the premises specified in those licences by him in the course of the business to which the licences relate during the respective terms of the licences last preceding the date on which the fee becomes payable divided by the number of those licences.”.

3. Regulation 6 of the Milk Authority Regulations is amended by omitting the words “the rate of 0.25 cents per gallon of milk sold or delivered in the Territory by the holder of the licence” and inserting in their stead the words “the rate of 0.34 cents for every dollar of the amount payable by the holder of the licence for milk and cream supplied to him by the holders of wholesaler’s licences for sale by him”.

4. Regulation 7 of the Milk Authority Regulations is amended by omitting all of the words from and including the words "the rate of 0.25 cents per gallon of milk" and inserting in their stead the words "the rate of 0.34 cents for every dollar of the amount payable by the holder of the permit for milk and cream supplied to him by the holders of wholesaler's licences for sale by him in the course of his business during the term of the permit last preceding the date on which the fee becomes payable."

5. Regulation 10 of the Milk Authority Regulations is amended by omitting sub-regulation (3.) and inserting in its stead the following sub-regulations:—

"(3.) Subject to sub-regulation (5.) of this regulation, there is payable to the Chairman of the Authority for each day on which he is engaged, with the approval of the Authority, on business of the Authority—

- (a) if the duration of the period during which he is so engaged on that day is not less than three hours—a fee of Forty dollars; or
- (b) if the duration of the period during which he is so engaged on that day is less than three hours—a fee of Twenty-five dollars.

"(4.) Subject to the next succeeding sub-regulation, there is payable to a member of the Authority other than the Chairman for each day on which he is engaged, with the approval of the Authority, on business of the Authority—

- (a) if the duration of the period during which he is so engaged on that day is not less than three hours—a fee of Thirty-five dollars; or
- (b) if the duration of the period during which he is so engaged on that day is less than three hours—a fee of Twenty dollars.

"(5.) Where the Chairman of the Authority or a member of the Authority—

- (a) attends, on a day, a meeting of the Authority; and
- (b) is also, on the same day, engaged for a period, with the approval of the Authority, on other business of the Authority,

a fee is not payable to him in accordance with sub-regulation (3.) or sub-regulation (4.) of this regulation in respect of the period referred to in paragraph (b) of this sub-regulation but the fee payable to him in respect of that day in accordance with sub-regulation (1.) or sub-regulation (2.) of this regulation is the fee that would be payable to him in respect of that day if, on that day, he had, in addition to attending the meeting referred to in paragraph (a) of this sub-regulation, also attended a meeting of the Authority during the period referred to in paragraph (b) of this sub-regulation.

"(6.) Where the Chairman of the Authority or a member of the Authority is necessarily absent overnight from his place of residence—

- (a) in order to attend a meeting of the Authority; or
- (b) in order to perform any business of the Authority on which he is engaged with the approval of the Authority,

travelling allowance in respect of the period of absence is payable to him at the rate of Twenty-five dollars per day.

"(7.) Travelling allowance payable under the last preceding sub-regulation is in addition to, and does not include, the cost of conveyance."

6. Regulation 12 of the Milk Authority Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (1.) the definition of "cream".
