Regulations under the *Canberra Retail Market Trust Ordinance 1971*.*

CANBERRA RETAIL MARKET TRUST REGULATIONS

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Canberra Retail Market Trust Regulations. Citation.

2.—(1.) The Chairman of the Trust shall be paid—

(a) in respect of his attendance on a day at a meeting of the Trust the duration of which on that day is not less than three hours—a fee of Forty dollars; and

(b) in respect of his attendance on a day at a meeting of the Trust the duration of which is less than three hours—a fee of Twenty-five dollars.

Fees payable
to trustees.

(2.) A trustee other than the Chairman shall be paid—

(a) in respect of his attendance on a day at a meeting of the Trust the duration of which on that day is not less than three hours—a fee of Thirty-five dollars; and

(b) in respect of his attendance on a day at a meeting of the Trust the duration of which on that day is less than three hours—a fee of Twenty dollars.

3. The Chairman of the Trust, and each trustee, shall, while travelling in connexion with the business of the Trust, be paid an allowance at the rate of twenty-one dollars for each day on which he is necessarily absent overnight from his place of residence. Allowances.
