Amendments of the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations†

- 1. Regulation 16 of the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations Premium rates, is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (2) all the words from and including the words "trader's plate" to the end of the sub-regulation and substituting the words "trader's plate is Sixty-seven dollars ninety cents".
- 2. The First Schedule to the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations is amended by omitting Part II and substituting the following Part:—
