Regulations under the Canberra Commercial Development Authority Ordinance 1974.*

CANBERRA COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY REGULATIONS

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Canberra Commercial Development Citation. Authority Regulations.
- 2. (1) The Chairman shall be paid in respect of each day on which he attends a meeting of the Authority—

Fees and allowances payable to members of the Authority.

- (a) if the duration of the meeting on that day is not less than 3 hours— members of the Authority.

 a fee of \$60; and
- (b) if the duration of the meeting on that day is less than 3 hours—a fee of \$40.
- (2) A member other than the Chairman shall be paid in respect of each day on which he attends a meeting of the Authority—
 - (a) if the duration of the meeting on that day is not less than 3 hours—a fee of \$50; and
 - (b) if the duration of the meeting on that day is less than 3 hours—a fee of \$30.
- (3) Subject to sub-regulation (5), the Chairman shall be paid for each day on which he is engaged, with the approval of the Authority, on business of the Authority—
 - (a) if the period during which he is so engaged on that day is not less than 3 hours—a fee of \$60; and
 - (b) if the period during which he is so engaged on that day is less than 3 hours—a fee of \$40.
- (4) Subject to sub-regulation (5), a member other than the Chairman shall be paid for each day on which he is engaged, with the approval of the Authority, on business of the Authority—
 - (a) if the period during which he is so engaged on that day is not less than 3 hours—a fee of \$50; and

- (b) if the period during which he is so engaged on that day is less than 3 hours—a fee of \$30.
- (5) Where a member-
 - (a) attends a meeting of the Authority; and
 - (b) is, on the same day, engaged for a period, with the approval of the Authority, on other business of the Authority,

a fee is not payable to that member in accordance with sub-regulation (3) or (4), but the fee payable to him in respect of that day in accordance with sub-regulation (1) or (2) is the fee that would be payable to him in respect of that day if, on that day, he had, in addition to attending the meeting referred to in paragraph (a), also attended a meeting of the Authority during the period referred to in paragraph (b).

- (6) Where-
 - (a) a member is necessarily absent overnight from his place of residence in order to attend a meeting of the Authority; or
 - (b) a member is necessarily absent overnight from his place of residence in order to perform any business of the Authority on which he is engaged with the approval of the Authority,

travelling allowance in respect of the period of absence is payable to him at the rate of \$37 per day.

(7) Travelling allowance payable under sub-regulation (6) is in addition to, and does not include, the cost of conveyance.
