## Regulations under the Plant Diseases Ordinance 1934*

## AMENDMENTS OF THE PLANT DISEASES REGULATIONS $\dagger$

1. Regulation 2 of the Plant Diseases Regulations is repealed. Parts

" 20. (1) A person shall not sell within the Territory, or export from the Territory, fruit packed in a case unless the case is of a description specified in column 1 of the Second Schedule and has the internal

"(2) In this regulation, ' case ' does not include a bag or sack.".
