AMENDMENTS OF THE MOTOR VEHICLE (THIRD PARTY INSURANCE) REGULATIONS†

1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 22 May 1978. Commencement
2. Regulation 16 of the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations is amended by omitting from sub-regulation (2) “\$98.00” and substituting “\$100.00”. Premium rates
3. The First Schedule to the Motor Vehicle (Third Party Insurance) Regulations is amended by omitting Part II and substituting the following Part: First Schedule
