AMENDMENT OF THE SCHOOLS AUTHORITY REGULATIONS²

Regulation 46 of the Schools Authority Regulations is repealed and the following regulation substituted:

“46. (1) Where the number of nominations received by the returning officer does not exceed the number of members of the board to be elected, the returning officer shall declare each candidate nominated to have been elected. Returning officer to declare nominations

“(2) Where the number of nominations received by the returning officer exceeds the number of candidates to be elected, the returning officer shall conduct a ballot in accordance with the determinations of the electoral meeting of the Student Council or students, as the case may be.”
