AMENDMENTS OF THE COMPANIES REGULATIONS

- 1. These Regulations shall come into operation on 1 February Commence-1981.
- 2. Regulation 24 of the Companies Regulations is amended by Prescribed Stock Exchanges

- (c) by leaving the notice with a person apparently over the age of 16 years at the officer's last known place of residence or business.

"58. For the purposes of sub-section 174 (5) of the Ordinance, the Fees and fees, and allowances for expenses, payable to an officer of a company required to attend for examination under Part VIA of the Ordinance person shall be such fees, and allowances for expenses, in accordance with the scale in the Second Schedule to the Public Works Committee Regulations as in force from time to time under the Public Works Committee Act 1969 as the person who conducts the examination determines.".
