1. Regulation 5 of the Pharmacy Regulations is repealed and the following regulation substituted:

Prescribed fees

"5. The prescribed fee for the purpose of a provision of the *Pharmacy Ordinance* 1931 specified in Column 1 of the following table is the amount specified in Column 2 of that table opposite to the reference to that provision.
